Ready to start your new, highly in-demand career?

Nursing assistants are currently needed throughout the state of Minnesota. Right now, through the state's nursing assistant initiative, you can become fully certified as an entry-level nursing assistant at no cost to you.

Become a nursing assistant in 4 steps

1

Visit www.ohe.state.mn.us/CNATraining and find a program in your area that fits your schedule. A variety of dates, times, hybrid and in-person options are currently offered with new free classes added through Feb. 2023.

2

Enroll and complete the 75-hour nursing assistant course for free. The average course lasts 2-3 weeks.

3

Take your certification exam. Once you have completed training, schedule your free certification exam. Your training provider can help with this process.

4

Start your new career and make a difference in your community. There are nearly 15,000 open CNA positions in the state. Once you are certified, connect with a long-term care facility or veteran's home in your area to apply.

- ✓ Nursing assistant course: *All tuition and fees*
- ✓ Uniform, books and required materials
- ✓ Certification exam

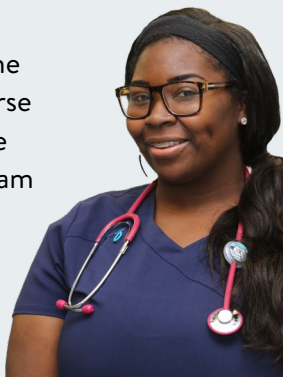

Program Eligibility

- ✓ Free nursing assistant training is open to Minnesotans who are 16 years or older and able to work in the U.S.
- ✓ Each program/college may have their own enrollment requirements
- ✓ Some training providers may require background checks
- ✓ All employers will require background checks
- ✓ Employers will require nursing assistants to be up-to-date on vaccinations, including the COVID-19 vaccination
